Violinist Emil Altschuler and Pianist Marvin Wolfthal will perform a selection of Bach, Brahms, DeBussy and Ravel at 7:00pm in the Function Room at Brush Hill. Pianist and composer Marvin Wolfthal was born in Bridgeport, Connecticut, where he studied piano with Murray and Loretta Dranoff. He studied composition at Columbia University with Charles Wuorinen and Harvey Sollberger and piano with Claudio Arrau and Rafael de Silva. He was a founder of the Columbia Chamber Players, which performed classics of early Twentieth Century music and gave several first New York performances of works by major composers, including Pierre Boulez. In 1972 he took up residence in Milan, Italy, where he was active as a performer, teacher, lecturer and author. He was an active participant in Italian musical life and was one of the founding directors of the program "Music in our Time" organized by the city of Milan. During this time Wolfthal performed widely, devoting particular attention to important American composers, including premieres of works by Roger Sessions, Donald Martino and Elliott Carter. He gave the Italian premiere of Elliott Carter's Piano Concerto at the Venice Biennial Festival with the Milan RAI Orchestra. On returning to the United States he joined the faculty of the Manhattan School of Music, where he taught graduate seminars in interpretation and advanced musical theory. He has presented graduate seminars in interpretation at the Longy School in Cambridge. Master violinist, Erick Friedman wrote of violinist Emil Altschuler "... a truly outstanding violinist of his generation ... and sound and accuracy of intonation that are truly extraordinary" and The Strad magazine praises "Passion and portamento from a young American violinist". And The Whole Note writes "There's a decidedly old-style feel to ... very reminiscent of Heifetz." He received his Bachelor of Music from The Juilliard School under Doherty DeLay and Naoko Tanaka and his Master of Music from The Yale School of Music under Erick Friedman. He has performed in Lincoln Center, San Francisco's Helen Von Ammon's Emerging Artist Series, The Aspen Music Festival, and Italy's Castello di Galeazza.
