Dear Residents of Fuller Village,

We, the Board of Directors of Fuller Village, hope this letter finds you, your neighbors and family members healthy and safe. We know these are trying times for all of you and appreciate your help and patience as our community works together to do our part to stop the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus).

The Fuller Village management team with our support has implemented measures to do our part; Serve Pro is sanitizing and wiping down all hard surfaces and common areas every other day, cancelled all group activities, closed the pool and fitness center, closed the Brush Hill café and Gordon House Dining Room, limiting all visitors to the buildings and encouraging staff to work remotely.

One of the many wonderful things we hear from residents is the community atmosphere at Fuller Village which makes the social distancing recommendation so difficult to adhere to, but please we strongly urge and implore you to follow the recommendation. Our resident population is one of the high-risk groups. Social distancing yourself protects you and all your neighbors.

Social distancing means staying in your home, maintaining 6 feet of distance if you are in contact with an individual and not gathering with groups of people. This includes playing mahjong, bridge and coffee hours. If you do need to go out, please limit your trips. It is recommended when you go to the grocery store to stock up, so you don't need to go for 2 weeks. With all these recommendations we are asking you to not gather in any of the common areas of Fuller Village.

Limiting our physical contact with each other does not mean we need to limit our social interaction; we just need to do it differently. We encourage you to create a buddy system to check on your neighbors via telephone and video calling. Reach out to those you may feel are lonely and in need of a friendly voice.
