Helpful Reminders. Please ensure your pull cords are readily accessible to use. For example, they cannot be hidden behind paintings or furniture. They will be of no use in an emergency situation if you cannot access them. For HVAC closets, please ensure you do not store items on top of, leaning on, or under your HVAC unit to ensure functional safety and avoid damaging the unit. During our Maintenance team's preventative maintenance tasks this month we identified the need to provide these important reminders. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

Villa Residents Only. Direct Energy will be changing its name to NRG. You will notice the name change on your invoices within the next few months. Nothing else will change.

Dining Slip Clarification. If you see the word "split" on your dining slip, it means that you have reached your \$60.00 dining amenity credit limit for the month and the portion that is over the \$60.00 is what is being charged to your account. If someone has a balance of left of \$10.00 of their \$60.00 credit and they order something for \$15.00, the charges are "split" with \$10.00 going towards the balance of their \$60.00 credit and \$5.00 being charged to their account plus the tax on the \$5.00. Fuller Village incurs the cost of meal tax for the \$60.00 dining amenity credit and residents pay the meal tax for anything over the \$60.00 for the month along with tax on alcohol.

COVID Status. Since Sunday July 9th, Fuller has had 3 additional individuals test positive for COVID. They are self-isolating, and symptoms are improving. Should you test COVID positive, we kindly ask that you notify Joey DiGiano at 617-361-3231 along with any close contact fellow residents.

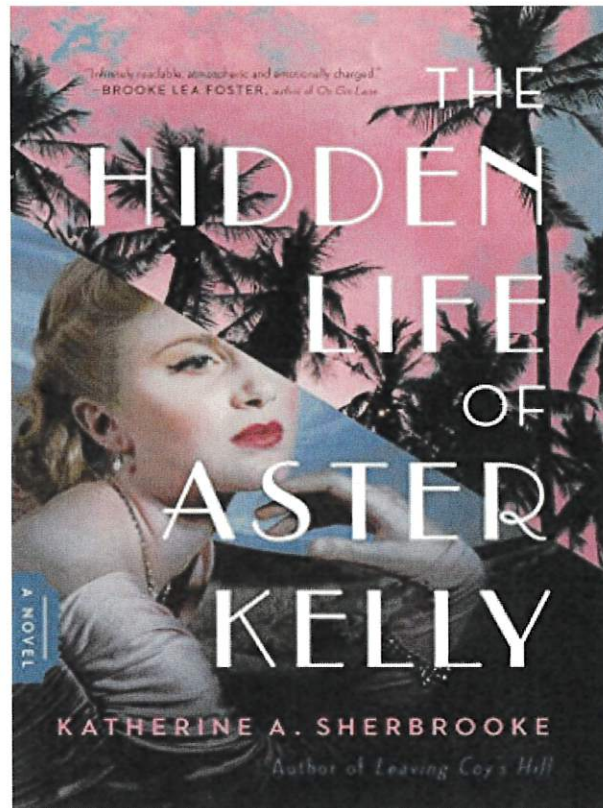

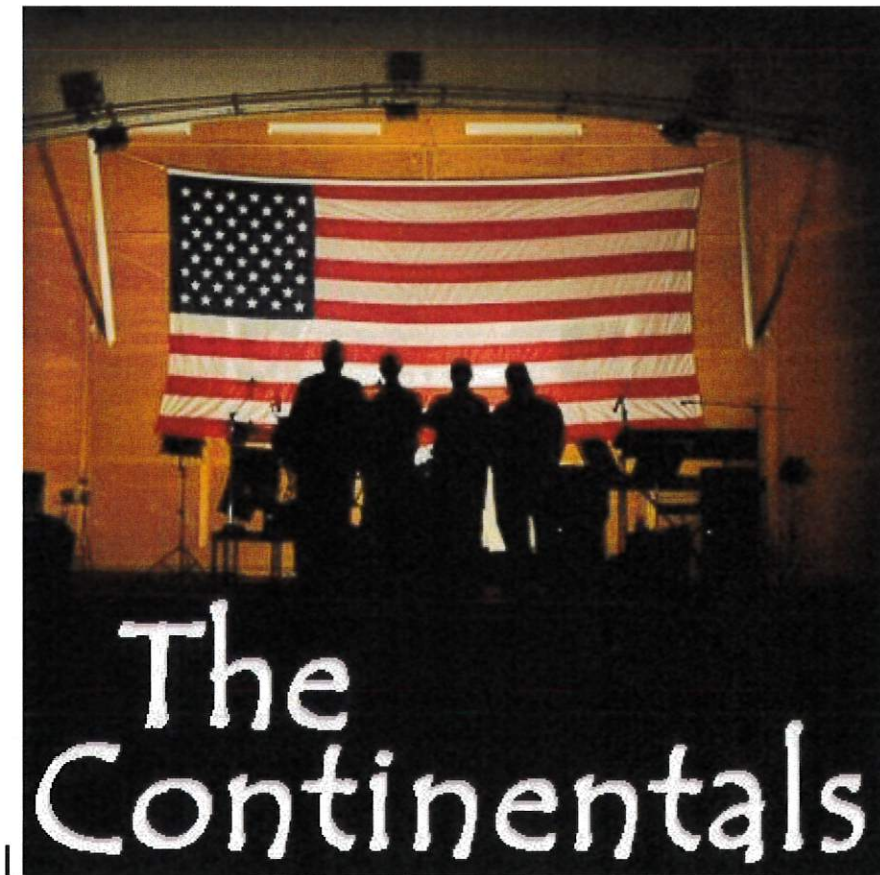

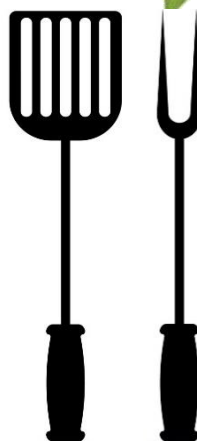

At this public site visit, the DCR team for the Neponset to Blue Hills Feasibility Study will lead a site visit to key project elements. The project team will convene at the Saint Pius X Parish, then lead participants to the project site in groups. Upon returning to the Parish, informational material will be provided and the project team will be present to answer questions and address concerns.

The distance of the walk is roughly 1.5 miles round trip. If you are not able to cover this distance on foot, please contact Daniel.cushing@mass.gov and accommodations will be provided.
