Our journey begins in **Millbury MA** as we visit the **Asa Water Mansion**. Prosperous gunsmith Asa Waters set out to build the stateliest residence in the country in 1826. With no expense spared, this home was designed for entertaining. His grand vision was a home that would stand as the brightest jewel in town. To celebrate the completion of the mansion in 1832, a grand Christmas Eve Ball was held.

Departing Millbury, we will journey to Dedham MA to the **MIT Endicott Mansion**. **Most have never seen** let alone visited this 42,000 sq ft French Chateau-styled house, as it is not visible from any street and is surrounded by 8-foot high stone walls. Built in 1934 amid the great depression by Wendel Endicott, it still retains many of its original features. **By very special arrangement enjoy a tour** of this home decorated for the holidays and a **private reception in the second-floor library and gun room with hors d'oeuvres**. Enjoy lunch inside the mansion.



Departing MIT Endicott, we will be joined by a historian for a **rolling tour of historic Dedham**. Learn about its fascinating history. For example, Dedham originally went to the Rhode Island line. **Sixteen towns were created from what was once Dedham**, including Wrentham, Natick, Wellesley, Norwood, Bellingham, and amazingly, Deerfield, MA, which is two hours from Dedham.
