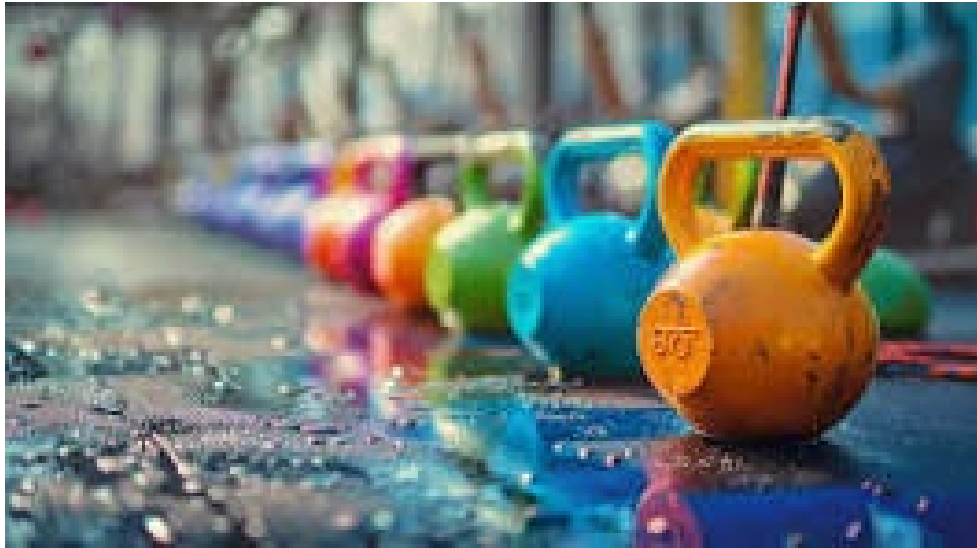

Officer and Representatives for Residents Association

Fuller Village is a vibrant community, as residents are engaged with the activities including the Residents Association. An overview of the Residents Association, which includes four Officers and twelve Representatives is provided on the inside cover of the Residents Telephone Directory. The Officer and Representative positions offer an opportunity to be involved *advocating for residents and enhancing the overall environment at Fuller Village.*

The four Officers of the Residents Association are elected for two years and are able to serve a maximum of two consecutive terms. Officers must be residents of Fuller Village for twelve months on September 30 of the year in which they seek election.

The twelve Representatives of the Residents Association are elected for a two-year term and are able to serve a maximum of three consecutive terms. New Fuller Village residents may apply, as there is no requirement that they be live in the community for any number of months.

On June 25, 2026, forms will be available at the concierge desks at Blue Hills and Brush Hill, as every Officer and Representative must fill out a form indicating their desire to remain on the Residents Association board. This year John Gallagher, Barbara Smith and Barbara Cocci have completed their term of office. The remaining Officers and Representatives must complete their form and submit it by July 17, 2026.
